


## Income

## WHO WE SERVED

**13,032 individuals** (7155 households) received food services (avoided food insecurity, helped fight hunger)

Kept **284 people** (136 households) from being evicted from their homes

Kept **2224 people** (812 households) from having their utilities disconnected

**862 people** (447 households) received special Christmas food baskets reflecting a “typical” Christmas meal

Helped **1256 people** develop skills through our Education and Empowerment programs

Provided **178 school children** new school clothes

**470 people** with transportation through gas/TARC cards

**267 people** with medicines and other medical needs

**948 households** received financial assistance to stabilize their situation for 30 days

**15,540 people** avoided food insecurity, homelessness and/or utility disconnections

**7155 households** were provided food

Delivered meals to **343 people** through our Meals on Wheels program

**408 deliveries** of commodities to home bound individuals

**18,262 services** were provided to those living in our service area.
